| 21 | "Military-connected student." A school-aged child who is a |
| 22 | dependent of any of the following: |
| 23 | (1) An active or a former member of any of the following: |
| 24 | (i) The United States Armed Forces serving in the United |
| 25 | States Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, Space Force or Coast |
| 26 | <u>Guard on active duty.</u> |
| 27 | <u>(ii) The Pennsylvania National Guard.</u> |
| 28 | (iii) A reserve force of the United States Armed Forces. |
| 29 | (2) A member specified under paragraph (1) who was killed in |
