INTRODUCED BY PITTMAN, HUTCHINSON AND STEFANO, FEBRUARY 14, 2022

REFERRED TO LOCAL GOVERNMENT, FEBRUARY 14, 2022

AN ACT

1 Amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), entitled "An
 2 act concerning townships of the second class; and amending,
 3 revising, consolidating and changing the law relating
 4 thereto," in auditors and accountants, further providing for
 5 auditor's compensation.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
 7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. Section 902(a) of the act of May 1, 1933
 9 (P.L.103, No.69), known as The Second Class Township Code, is
 10 amended and the section is amended by adding subsections to
 11 read:

12 Section 902. Auditor's Compensation.--(a) Each auditor
 13 shall receive ten dollars (\$10) for each hour necessarily
 14 employed in the duties of the office upon presentation to the
 15 board of supervisors of an itemized listing of the dates, times,
 16 places and hours worked to perform the audit. No auditor in a
 17 township having a population of ten thousand or less is entitled
 18 to receive more than [one thousand dollars (\$1,000)] one
 19 thousand seven hundred dollars (\$1,700) for completing the
 20 annual audit, settlement and adjustment. No auditor in a

1 township having a population in excess of ten thousand is
2 entitled to receive more than [two thousand dollars (\$2,000)]
3 three thousand four hundred dollars (\$3,400) for completing the
4 annual audit, settlement and adjustment.

5 (a.1) The board of supervisors may, by adoption of a
6 resolution, increase the rate of compensation for each auditor
7 under subsection (a) to an amount not greater than seventeen
8 dollars (\$17) for each hour necessarily employed in the duties
9 of the office upon presentation to the board of supervisors of
10 an itemized listing of the dates, times, places and hours worked
11 to perform the audit.

13 (b.1) The board of supervisors may, by adoption of a
14 resolution, increase the rate of compensation for each auditor
15 under subsection (b) to an amount not greater than seventeen
16 dollars (\$17) per hour for not more than fifty hours to audit
17 the accounts of any public official who handles public funds
18 when a vacancy occurs in the office of the public official.

20 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
