## AN ACT

- Amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in grants to fire companies and 2 emergency medical services companies, further providing for 3 award of grants and providing for COVID-19 Fire Company Grant 5 Program. 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 7 hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. Section 7813(a)(7) of Title 35 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: § 7813. Award of grants. 10 Authorization. -- The commissioner is authorized to make a 11 grant award to each eligible fire company for the following: 12 \* \* \* 13 14 (7) Revenue loss for grants issued in 2021 [and], 2022 15 and 2023.

- 7 § 7816. Establishment.
- 8 The COVID-19 Fire Company Grant Program is established and
- 9 shall be administered by the agency. Grants provided under the
- 10 program shall be used by fire companies to provide services
- 11 <u>during the novel coronavirus pandemic as identified in the</u>
- 12 proclamation of disaster emergency issued by the Governor on
- 13 March 6, 2020, published at 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020), and
- 14 any renewal of the state of disaster emergency.
- 15 § 7817. Publication and notice.
- 16 The agency shall transmit notice of the COVID-19 Fire Company
- 17 Grant Program availability to the Legislative Reference Bureau
- 18 for publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin within 30 days of
- 19 the effective date of this section.
- 20 § 7818. Award of grants.
- 21 (a) Authorization. -- The agency shall make a grant award from
- 22 the COVID-19 Fire Company Grant Program to:
- 23 (1) Each eligible fire company that received a grant
- award in fiscal year 2020-2021 under section 7813 (relating
- 25 to award of grants) for the purposes under section 7813(a)
- 26 and (a.1).
- 27 (2) A fire company that did not apply for or receive a
- 28 grant award in fiscal year 2020-2021 under section 7813 and
- 29 that applies for a grant under this subchapter for the
- purposes under section 7813(a) and (a.1).

- 1 (b) Amount of award. -- The amount of the grant award under
- 2 this subchapter shall be as follows:
- 3 (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2), grants shall be
- 4 not less than \$2,500 and not more than \$50,000 per fire
- 5 company.
- 6 (2) Grants may be awarded on a pro rata basis if the
- 7 <u>total dollar amount of the approved applications exceeds the</u>
- 8 amount of funds appropriated by the General Assembly for this
- 9 <u>purpose</u>.
- 10 (c) Application not required. --
- 11 (1) Except as otherwise provided in paragraph (2), no
- 12 <u>additional application shall be required for a grant under</u>
- 13 <u>this subchapter.</u>
- 14 (2) A fire company under subsection (a) (2) must file an
- application for a grant under this subchapter.
- 16 (d) Reports. -- Following the completion of the program under
- 17 this subchapter, the agency shall issue a report, including the
- 18 following:
- 19 (1) The impact of the program on fire companies.
- 20 (2) The list of the awardees.
- 21 Section 3. Title 35 is amended by adding a section to read:
- 22 § 7832.3. COVID-19 Fire Company Grant Program.
- 23 From the appropriation from money received by the
- 24 Commonwealth under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (Public
- 25 Law 117-2, 135 Stat. 4) for purposes of making grants under
- 26 Subchapter B.1 (relating to COVID-19 Fire Company Grant
- 27 Program), the sum of \$125,000,000 of the amount appropriated
- 28 shall be expended for the purpose of making grants to eligible
- 29 <u>fire companies.</u>
- 30 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
