1 2 3	Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in authorized disposition of offenders, providing for restitution involving child support.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
8	§ 1107.2. Restitution involving child support.
9	(a) Order Notwithstanding any other provision of law and
10	in addition to any other sentence or order authorized by law,
11	the court shall sentence a person convicted of a designated
12	offense that resulted in the death of a parent of a child to pay
13	child support for the child as restitution. The following apply:
14	(1) The amount of the child support shall be determined
15	in accordance with 23 Pa.C.S. § 4322 (relating to support
16	guideline).
17	(2) The payment of child support shall be made to the

surviving parent of the child or, in the absence of a

- 2 custody of the child.
- 3 (3) The payment of child support shall be made until the
- 4 <u>child reaches 18 years of age.</u>
- 5 (b) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
- 6 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 7 <u>subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 8 "Child." An individual under 18 years of age.
- 9 <u>"Designated offense." An offense under any of the following:</u>
- 10 (1) Section 2502 (relating to murder).
- 11 (2) Section 2503 (relating to voluntary manslaughter).
- 12 (3) Section 2504 (relating to involuntary manslaughter).
- 13 (4) 75 Pa.C.S. § 3732 (relating to homicide by vehicle).
- 14 (5) 75 Pa.C.S. § 3735 (relating to homicide by vehicle
- while driving under influence).
- 16 "Parent." A biological parent, adoptive parent or legal
- 17 quardian of a child.
- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
