AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, in other required equipment, further providing for
3 visual signals on authorized vehicles.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 4572(b) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 4572. Visual signals on authorized vehicles.

9 * * *

10 (b) Flashing or revolving yellow or blue lights.--Vehicles
11 authorized pursuant to the provisions of sections 6106 (relating
12 to designation of emergency vehicles by Pennsylvania State
13 Police) and 6107 (relating to designation of authorized vehicles
14 by department), tow trucks and vehicles used for snow removal
15 may be equipped with one or more flashing or revolving yellow
16 lights. The manner in which the light or lights shall be
17 displayed and the intensity shall be determined by regulation of
18 the department. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the

1 following vehicles may be equipped with one or more flashing or
2 revolving blue lights in addition to the use of yellow lights
3 under this subsection:

4 (1) A tow truck, if the blue lights are equipped only in
5 the rear of the vehicle. A tow truck under this paragraph may
6 only operate blue lights while the tow truck is stationary on
7 the side of the road or highway while responding to a
8 disabled vehicle. The tow truck operating under this
9 paragraph is prohibited from operating blue lights at any
10 time while the tow truck is in motion.

13 Section 2. All regulations and parts of regulations are
14 abrogated to the extent of any inconsistency with the provisions
15 of this act.

16 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
