- Amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in domestic and sexual violence victim 2 address confidentiality, further providing for definitions, 3 for persons eligible to apply and for application and certification process. 5 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. Section 6702 of Title 23 of the Pennsylvania 9 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding definitions to read: SECTION 1. THE DEFINITION OF "VICTIM OF SEXUAL ASSAULT" IN 10 <--11 SECTION 6702 OF TITLE 23 OF THE PENNSYLVANIA CONSOLIDATED 12 STATUTES IS AMENDED AND THE SECTION IS AMENDED BY ADDING 13 DEFINITIONS TO READ: § 6702. Definitions. 14 15 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter 16 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the 17 context clearly indicates otherwise:

- 5 <u>"Victim of human trafficking." A victim of an offense</u>
- 6 <u>enumerated in either 18 Pa.C.S. § 3011 (relating to trafficking</u>
- 7 <u>in individuals</u>) or 3012 (relating to involuntary servitude).
- 8 "VICTIM OF KIDNAPPING." A VICTIM OF AN OFFENSE THAT IS
- 9 ENUMERATED IN 18 PA.C.S. § 2901 (RELATING TO KIDNAPPING).
- 10 "VICTIM OF SEXUAL ASSAULT." A VICTIM OF AN OFFENSE
- 11 ENUMERATED IN 18 PA.C.S. §§ 3121 (RELATING TO RAPE), <u>3133</u>
- 12 (RELATING TO SEXUAL EXTORTION), 4302 (RELATING TO INCEST), 6312
- 13 (RELATING TO SEXUAL ABUSE OF CHILDREN), 6318 (RELATING TO
- 14 UNLAWFUL CONTACT WITH MINOR) AND 6320 (RELATING TO SEXUAL
- 15 EXPLOITATION OF CHILDREN).

- 17 Section 2. Section 6704 of Title 23 is amended by adding
- 18 paragraphs to read:
- 19 § 6704. Persons eligible to apply.
- The following persons shall be eligible to apply to become

- 23 (6) A victim of child abduction who files an affidavit <--
- 24 with the Office of Victim Advocate describing the
- 25 perpetrator's course of conduct or repeated actions toward
- 26 the affiant meeting the criteria enumerated in 18 Pa.C.S. §
- 27 2904 (relating to interference with custody of children) that
- 28 <u>is graded as a felony and further stating that the affiant</u>
- 29 fears future violent acts by the perpetrator of the child
- 30 abduction.

- 1 (6) A VICTIM OF KIDNAPPING WHO FILES AN AFFIDAVIT WITH <--
- 2 THE OFFICE OF VICTIM ADVOCATE DESCRIBING THE PERPETRATOR'S
- 3 CONDUCT TOWARD THE AFFIANT MEETING THE CRITERIA ENUMERATED IN
- 4 <u>18 PA.C.S. § 2901 (RELATING TO KIDNAPPING) AND FURTHER</u>
- 5 STATING THAT THE AFFIANT FEARS FUTURE VIOLENT ACTS BY THE
- 6 PERPETRATOR OF THE KIDNAPPING.
- 7 (7) A victim of human trafficking who files an affidavit
- 8 <u>with the Office of Victim Advocate describing the</u>
- 9 <u>perpetrator's course of conduct or repeated actions toward</u>
- the affiant meeting the criteria enumerated in either 18
- 11 Pa.C.S. § 3011 (relating to trafficking in individuals) or
- 12 3012 (relating to involuntary servitude) and further stating
- that the affiant fears future violent acts by the perpetrator
- of the human trafficking.
- 15 Section 3. Section 6705(a) of Title 23 is amended to read:
- 16 § 6705. Application and certification process.
- 17 (a) General rule.--A person must file an application with
- 18 the Office of Victim Advocate on a form prescribed by the Office
- 19 of Victim Advocate. An application and any supporting
- 20 <u>documentation may be filed electronically, by mail or in person.</u>
- 21 The Office of Victim Advocate shall certify eligible applicants
- 22 as program participants in accordance with the procedures
- 23 outlined in subsection (b). Certification shall be valid for a
- 24 period of three years following the date of certification unless
- 25 the certification is withdrawn or canceled before the expiration
- 26 of that period.

- 28 Section 4. The Office of Victim Advocate may promulgate
- 29 regulations to effectuate the following:
- 30 (1) The addition of the definitions of "victim of child <--

- 1 abduction KIDNAPPING" and "victim of human trafficking" AND <--
- 2 "VICTIM OF KIDNAPPING" in 23 Pa.C.S. § 6702.
- 3 (2) The amendment or addition of 23 Pa.C.S. §§ 6704(6)
- 4 and (7) and 6705(a).
- 5 Section 5. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
