AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in reimbursement by Commonwealth and between school districts, providing for level-up supplemental
- basic education funding for the 2021-2022 school year.
- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 11 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 12 section to read:
- 13 <u>Section 2502.55. Level-up Supplemental Basic Education</u>
- 14 Funding for the 2021-2022 School Year.--(a) From money
- 15 appropriated for payment of basic education funding to school
- 16 districts in the 2022-2023 fiscal year, the Commonwealth shall
- 17 pay to qualifying school districts an allocation for the 2021-
- 18 2022 school year payable in the 2022-2023 fiscal year as
- 19 <u>follows:</u>
- 20 (1) There shall be a determination of the qualifying school

- 1 <u>districts with an amount less than or equal to the amount that</u>
- 2 <u>represents the twentieth percentile for all school districts.</u>
- 3 For each of the five preceding school years, the determination
- 4 shall be calculated as follows:
- 5 (i) For each school district, the sum of the amount of
- 6 student weights calculated under section 2502.53(c)(1)(ii),
- 7 (iii), (iv), (v) and (vi) and the amount of weighted special
- 8 <u>education headcounts calculated under section 2509.5(bbb)(2)(i).</u>
- 9 <u>(ii) For each school district, divide the current</u>
- 10 expenditures by the sum calculated for the school district in
- 11 <u>subparagraph (i).</u>
- 12 (iii) For each school district, calculate the average of the
- 13 <u>quotients calculated under subparagraph (ii).</u>
- 14 (2) Qualifying school districts determined under paragraph
- 15 (1) shall receive an amount calculated as follows:
- 16 (i) For each qualifying school district, multiply the
- 17 product in section 2502.53(b)(2)(i) for the 2021-2022 school
- 18 year by three hundred million dollars (\$300,000,000).
- 19 (ii) Divide the product in subparagraph (i) by the sum of
- 20 the products in section 2502.53(b)(2)(i) for the 2021-2022
- 21 school year for all qualifying school districts.
- 22 (b) Payments made under this section shall be deemed to be
- 23 part of the school district's allocation amount under section
- 24 2502.53(b)(1) for the 2022-2023 school year and each school year
- 25 thereafter.
- 26 (c) The provisions of sections 2502.53 and 2509.5 shall
- 27 apply to the calculation of the respective factors in this
- 28 section.
- 29 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
