AN ACT

1 Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, in Pennsylvania National Guard,
3 further providing for pay of officers and enlisted personnel
4 on special duty and for pay of officers and enlisted
5 personnel in active State service; in Pennsylvania Guard,
6 further providing for pay and expenses of officers and
7 enlisted personnel; and making editorial changes.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. Sections 3101 and 3102(a) of Title 51 of the
11 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:

12 § 3101. Pay of officers and enlisted personnel on special duty.

13 Members of the Pennsylvania National Guard or Pennsylvania
14 Guard may be ordered upon special duty at the discretion of the
15 Governor and shall receive the pay and allowances of their
16 respective grades during the time they may continue upon duty
17 under such order. Notwithstanding any provisions of the current
18 Armed Forces Pay and Allowance Act, the pay of any such
19 personnel shall not be less than \$180 per day. As used in this
20 section, the term "current Armed Forces Pay and Allowance Act"

1 means 37 U.S.C. (relating to pay and allowances of the uniformed
2 services) or a successor statute.

3 § 3102. Pay of officers and enlisted personnel in active State
4 service.

5 (a) General rule.--When the Pennsylvania National Guard or
6 Pennsylvania Guard, or any part thereof, is ordered on active
7 duty for State service by the Governor as Commander-in-Chief and
8 pay is authorized for such duty under the order prescribing the
9 performance thereof, the commissioned officers, warrant officers
10 and enlisted personnel so ordered shall be entitled to the same
11 pay and allowances and transportation in kind provided for in
12 the current Armed Forces Pay and Allowance Act. Notwithstanding
13 any provisions of such act, the pay of any such personnel shall
14 not be less than [~~\$100~~] \$180 per day. As used in this
15 subsection, the term "current Armed Forces Pay and Allowance
16 Act" means 37 U.S.C. (relating to pay and allowances of the
17 uniformed services) or a successor statute.

19 Section 2. Section 3301 of Title 51 is amended by adding a
20 subsection to read:

21 § 3301. Pay and expenses of officers and enlisted personnel.

23 (d) Definition.--As used in this section, the term "current
24 Armed Forces Pay and Allowance Act" means 37 U.S.C. (relating to
25 pay and allowances of the uniformed services) or a successor
26 statute.

27 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
