AN ACT

- Amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in employees, providing for medals
- 3 honoring law enforcement officers.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Chapter 21 of Title 53 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subchapter to read:
- 8 SUBCHAPTER F
- 9 MEDALS HONORING LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS

- 11 <u>2191</u>. <u>Establishment of program</u>.
- 12 2192. Medal procedure.
- 13 2193. Form of medals.
- 14 § 2191. Establishment of program.
- 15 A program is established for the Governor to recognize and
- 16 decorate law enforcement officers in this Commonwealth who have

- 1 <u>demonstrated bravery</u>, <u>sacrifice or other exceptionally</u>
- 2 meritorious conduct in the line of duty. The Municipal Police
- 3 Officers' Education and Training Commission established in
- 4 <u>Subchapter D (relating to municipal police education and</u>
- 5 training) shall assist the Governor in the administration of the
- 6 program by establishing the qualifications, protocol and other
- 7 rules necessary to carry out the purposes of this subchapter.
- 8 <u>§ 2192. Medal procedure.</u>
- 9 (a) Nominees. -- A member of the Pennsylvania State Police,
- 10 sheriff, as defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 6102 (relating to
- 11 definitions), or deputy sheriff or a police officer of a police
- 12 department as defined in section 2162 (relating to definitions)
- 13 may be nominated for a medal under this subchapter.
- 14 (b) Application. -- An application that nominates a law
- 15 enforcement officer for a medal may be submitted to the
- 16 <u>Municipal Police Officers' Education and Training Commission by</u>
- 17 the Governor, a member of the General Assembly, the Commissioner
- 18 of the Pennsylvania State Police, a county sheriff or the chief
- 19 executive of a municipality or police department.
- 20 (c) Review and issuance of medals. -- The Municipal Police
- 21 Officers' Education and Training Commission shall review an
- 22 application's veracity and conformance to the criteria of the
- 23 program and notify the Governor of the applications that are in
- 24 compliance. The final decision to issue a medal under this
- 25 subchapter shall rest with the Governor. The Governor may
- 26 <u>delegate to the Lieutenant Governor or a member of the General</u>
- 27 Assembly the act of presenting a medal.
- 28 § 2193. Form of medals.
- 29 (a) General rule. -- The medals authorized under the program
- 30 shall be in the following forms:

- 1 (1) Blue Star of Valor, which may be awarded to law
- 2 <u>enforcement officers who have shown exceptional gallantry</u>,
- 3 <u>heroism and bravery in the face of life-threatening</u>
- 4 <u>circumstances above and beyond the call of duty.</u>
- 5 (2) Blue Heart, which may be issued to law enforcement
- 6 <u>officers injured in the line of duty.</u>
- 7 (3) Medal of Ultimate Sacrifice, which shall be issued
- 8 <u>posthumously to law enforcement officers who have fallen in</u>
- 9 <u>the line of duty.</u>
- 10 (b) Design. -- The design of each medal shall be approved by
- 11 the Municipal Police Officers' Education and Training
- 12 <u>Commission. Each medal shall be cast in bronze or other metal</u>
- 13 <u>and the design shall incorporate the seal of the Commonwealth.</u>
- 14 (c) Cost.--The cost of a medal shall be paid by the
- 15 Pennsylvania State Police, county sheriff's department or the
- 16 police department by which the law enforcement officer is or was
- 17 employed. The family of a medal recipient may request a second
- 18 medal and may receive the medal upon payment to the Municipal
- 19 Police Officers' Education and Training Commission of the cost
- 20 of the medal.
- 21 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
