5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Section 6109(a)(3) of Title 75 of the
8	Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is
9	amended by adding a subsection to read:
10	§ 6109. Specific powers of department and local authorities.
11	(a) Enumeration of police powersThe provisions of this
12	title shall not be deemed to prevent the department on State-
13	designated highways and local authorities on streets or highways
14	within their physical boundaries from the reasonable exercise of
15	their police powers. The following are presumed to be reasonable
16	exercises of police power:

18	(3) [Regulating] <u>Subject to subsection (j), regulating</u>

19 or prohibiting processions, special activities or assemblages

3	(j) Permits for processions, special activities and
4	assemblages on State-designated highwaysThe department may
5	not require, as a condition for the approval of a permit for a
6	procession, special activity or assemblage on a State-designated
7	highway, a local authority to submit a statement that the local
8	authority will agree to fully indemnify, save harmless and
9	defend the Commonwealth, Commonwealth departments and their
10	officers, agents and employees from and against claims, suits or
11	actions for injury, death or property damage arising from or
12	because of the acts or omissions of its officers, agents or
13	employees or of the sponsor of the procession, special activity
14	or assemblage, unless all of the following conditions are met:
15	(1) The sponsor of the procession, special activity or
16	assemblage is not the local authority.
17	(2) The sponsor will fully indemnify, save harmless and,
18	if requested, defend the Commonwealth, Commonwealth
19	departments, and their officers, agents and employees from
20	and against claims, suits or actions for injury, death or
21	property damage arising from or because of the acts or
22	omissions of the sponsor, its officers, agents or employees.
23	(3) The sponsor names the department as an additional
24	insured on its liability policies and the liability insurance
25	policies are occurrence based and the insurance certificate
26	indicates that the insurance is occurrence based.
27	(4) The sponsor agrees to reimburse the Commonwealth for
28	all costs for police escort and traffic-control services.
29	(5) The local authority approves of the sponsor
30	conducting the procession, special activity or assemblage.

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1	(6) The local authority agrees to provide adequate
2	detour signing or police controls for the rerouting of
3	traffic along an alternate route, if requested by the
4	<u>department.</u>
5	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
