- 9 WHEREAS, As a result of accidents, inclement weather and
- 10 serious illnesses, there is traditionally an increased demand on
- 11 blood bank supplies; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Donating blood is a simple, safe, lifesaving and
- 13 selfless gift that millions of Americans are eligible to give;
