A RESOLUTION

1 Urging the Congress of the United States to fund and preserve  
2 the United States Postal Service.

3 WHEREAS, For more than 200 years the United States Postal  
4 Service has provided the essential public service of securely  
5 delivering the mail to every United States address six days a  
6 week at affordable rates; and

7 WHEREAS, Due to legislative mandates, restructuring and a  
8 denial of relief funds, the United States Postal Service is  
9 straining under debilitating financial losses; and

10 WHEREAS, Without Congressional action, the United States  
11 Postal Service faces imminent financial collapse; therefore be  
12 it

13 RESOLVED, That the Senate of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
14 urge the Congress of the United States to fund and preserve the  
15 United States Postal Service; and be it further

16 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to  
17 the presiding officers of each house of Congress and to each  
18 member of Congress from Pennsylvania.
