## A RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the Senate, further providing for committees.
RESOLVED, That Senate Rule $14(\mathrm{a})(1)$ be amended to read:
Rule 14. Committees.
(a) Standing committees.--
(1) There shall be the following permanent standing committees, the Chair, the Vice Chair and members thereof to be appointed by the President Pro Tempore as soon as possible after the election of the President Pro Tempore in sessions convening in odd-numbered years or such other times as may be necessary. The composition of each standing committee shall [reasonably reflect the caucus composition of the Senate membership] be equally divided between the Majority party, including Senators who caucus with the Majority party, and the Minority party, including Senators who caucus with the Minority party.
