- Amending the Rules of the Senate, further providing for committees and for video feed and audio feed. 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 hereby resolves as follows: RESOLVED, That Senate Rules 14(q)(3) and 23(d) and (e)(4) be 5 amended to read: 7 Rule 14. Committees. 8 9 (g) Public meetings or hearings. --* * * 10 11 [The] All meetings of the Senate standing and 12 special committees [may] shall be livestreamed [as determined 13 by the committee chair], if held in a hearing room equipped 14 for that purpose, and posted on the official Senate Internet 15 website. The official Senate livestream and recordings of the 16 livestream, video or audio, [may] shall be broadcasted and
- 18 <u>posted on</u> social media platforms. The restrictions on video

- 8 (d) Scope of video and audio feeds.--
- 9 (1) The video feed and audio feed shall provide a
 10 complete, unedited record of what is said on the Floor of the
 11 Senate and shall be free from commentary.
 - (2) To the extent possible, [only] the video cameras shall be focused on the Senate Floor. When necessary, the presiding officer and the persons actually speaking shall be covered by the video cameras and microphones.
- 16 (3) During roll call votes and other votes, the video
 17 cameras shall be focused on the [presiding officer or the
 18 appropriate clerks] Senate Floor until the announcement of
 19 the vote tabulation by the presiding officer.
- 20 [(4) During recesses of the Senate or when the Senate is 21 at ease, the video feed and audio feed shall be turned off.
- 22 (5)] (4) During guest introductions, video feed of 23 guests seated in the Senate Gallery or on the floor of the 24 Senate is permissible.
- 25 (e) Restrictions on video and audio feeds.--
- 26 * * *
- 27 (4) The President Pro Tempore or any other presiding
 28 officer shall be prohibited from ordering[, without consent
 29 of the Senate,] that any segment of a Floor session not be
 30 broadcast or recorded.
