A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the week of May 9 through 15, 2021, as "National Hospital Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania hospitals and health systems ensure
- 4 that health care services are available in this Commonwealth 24
- 5 hours a day, seven days a week, providing acute inpatient care
- 6 as well as outpatient, emergency, behavioral health,
- 7 rehabilitation, long-term and home care; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania's 42 trauma centers, seven burn centers
- 9 and 16 critical access hospitals deliver specialized care for
- 10 the most rural populations in this Commonwealth; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania is home to seven medical degree-
- 12 granting schools as well as numerous academic medical centers
- 13 and teaching hospitals that train future health care providers
- 14 and invest in critical health research; and
- 15 WHEREAS, "National Hospital Week" dates back to 1921, in
- 16 Chicago, as an event to build trust following the Spanish
- 17 influenza outbreak; and

- 1 WHEREAS, The observance is a reminder that hospitals are
- 2 foundations of the communities that built them, serving people
- 3 from all walks of life; and
- 4 WHEREAS, "National Hospital Week" celebrates hospitals and
- 5 the people who support the health of their communities with
- 6 dedication and compassion; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania hospitals are multidimensional,
- 8 partnering with other community organizations to offer health
- 9 care services that focus on health promotion, disease prevention
- 10 and wellness; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania hospitals provide free health care
- 12 services to individuals who have no health insurance or
- 13 inadequate health insurance coverage, providing nearly \$836.5
- 14 million in uncompensated care during 2019; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania hospitals contributed more than \$143
- 16 billion to this Commonwealth's economy during 2019; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania hospitals are among the leading
- 18 employers in their communities, supporting approximately 660,000
- 19 jobs, directly and indirectly; therefore be it
- 20 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the week of May 9 through
- 21 15, 2021, as "National Hospital Week" in Pennsylvania; and be it

- 24 hospitals in their communities to learn about the innovative,
- 25 quality care and services that are improving the health and
- 26 well-being of residents of this Commonwealth.
