A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing June 14, 2021, as "National Flag Day" in
2 Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, The flag consisting of "thirteen stripes, alternate
4 red and white; that the Union be thirteen stars, white in a blue
5 field, representing a new Constellation" was adopted by
6 resolution of the Second Continental Congress on June 14, 1777;
7 and

8 WHEREAS, On June 14, 1937, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9 became the first state of the Union to celebrate Flag Day as an
10 official state holiday; and

11 WHEREAS, The flag we fondly know today as the "Stars and
12 Stripes" continues to unify our Nation's fifty states as one
13 Great Republic; therefore be it

14 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize June 14, 2021, as
15 "National Flag Day" in Pennsylvania; and be it further

16 RESOLVED, That the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania shall
17 continue to recognize "Flag Day" and honor the flag of the
18 United States of America, a symbol of hope and freedom; and be

2 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize those who sacrificed and
3 fought gallantly with perseverance, determination and valor for
4 our Nation in its quest for liberty and justice, standing united
5 as One Nation Under God.
