- 4 WHEREAS, Hispanics have contributed significantly to the
- extraordinary diversity and progress of our Commonwealth and our 5
- 6 nation; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Hispanics represent the fastest-growing minority
- ethnic group in our Commonwealth and our nation; and 8
- 9 WHEREAS, With a median age of 30 years, Hispanics comprise
- 10 the youngest minority ethnic group in the United States; and
- WHEREAS, An average of 900,000 young persons of Hispanic 11
- 12 origin are projected to become eligible to vote each year
- 13 through 2028; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania's ethnically diverse population
- 15 features nearly 1 million Hispanic residents, including
- individuals of Puerto Rican, Mexican and Dominican descent; and 16
- WHEREAS, With roots in Spain, Mexico, the Caribbean, Central 17
- America and South America, Hispanic Americans culturally enrich 18

- 1 our communities, spur business and industry and commit to
- 2 careers in law enforcement, military service and public service;

- 7 WHEREAS, The Latinx population in the United States is
- 8 projected to grow to 31% of the total United States population
