A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the week of November 13 through 19, 2022, as "Nurse Practitioner Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Nurse practitioners (NPs) serve as trusted frontline
- 4 providers of health care for patients in this Commonwealth; and
- 5 WHEREAS, NPs are advanced practice registered nurses who have
- 6 advanced clinical education and training building upon their
- 7 initial registered nurse preparation; and
- 8 WHEREAS, There are 325,000 licensed NPs in the United States
- 9 and more than 16,300 NPs in this Commonwealth providing primary,
- 10 acute and specialty care to patients of all ages and walks of
- 11 life; and
- 12 WHEREAS, NPs diagnose, treat and prescribe medications and
- 13 other treatments to patients through a caring, patient-centered,
- 14 holistic model of care; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Residents of this Commonwealth and nation have great
- 16 trust in the high-quality care NPs provide, resulting in more
- 17 than 1 billion patient visits annually to NPs across the

- 2 WHEREAS, Six decades of research demonstrate the high quality
- 3 of care provided by NPs; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Better utilization of NPs through modernized State
- 5 laws and improved policies creates better health through a more
- 6 accessible, efficient, cost-effective and higher-quality health
- 7 care system; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Twenty-six states and the District of Columbia have
- 9 implemented "full practice authority" for NPs, granting patients
- 10 full and direct access to the outstanding care offered by these
- 11 health care providers; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Leading governmental and policy entities, including
- 13 the National Academy of Medicine, National Council of State
- 14 Boards of Nursing, National Governors Association and Federal
- 15 Trade Commission, have taken notice of the benefits of full
- 16 practice authority for NPs and have endorsed such a regulatory
- 17 model; and
- 18 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is proud to
- 19 recognize and honor the service of NPs to this Commonwealth;
- 20 therefore be it
- 21 RESOLVED (the House of Representatives concurring), That the
- 22 General Assembly recognize the week of November 13 through 19,
- 23 2022, as "Nurse Practitioner Week" in Pennsylvania.
