Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in size, weight and load, further providing for limits on number of towed vehicles, for length of vehicles 3 and for application to tow trucks. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 4904(c)(2) of Title 75 of the 8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 9 § 4904. Limits on number of towed vehicles. * * * 10 11 (c) Towing vehicles requiring service. --12 A combination, including a truck tractor with no 13 more than two trailers, requiring emergency service may be 14 15 towed to a [nearby garage or other place of safety.] place of 16 repairs of the owner's choosing or other place of safety off 17 of a highway as provided under sections 4923 (relating to length of vehicles) and 4949 (relating to application to tow 18 19 trucks).

- 20 available such location and the movement is performed at the
- 21 direction of authorized emergency personnel or a qualified
- 22 Commonwealth employee] place of repairs or place of safety.
