AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), entitled "An act relating to tax reform and State taxation by codifying 2 and enumerating certain subjects of taxation and imposing 3 taxes thereon; providing procedures for the payment, collection, administration and enforcement thereof; providing for tax credits in certain cases; conferring powers and 7 imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue, certain employers, fiduciaries, individuals, persons, corporations 8 and other entities; prescribing crimes, offenses and 9 penalties," in personal income tax, further providing for 10 classes of income. 11 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: 14 Section 1. Section 303(a)(1)(i) of the act of March 4, 1971 15 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, is amended 16 to read: 17 Section 303. Classes of Income. -- (a) The classes of income 18 referred to above are as follows: 19 (1) Compensation.
- 20 (i) All salaries, wages, commissions, bonuses and incentive
- payments whether based on profits or otherwise, fees, tips and 21
- similar remuneration received for services rendered whether

- 1 directly or through an agent and whether in cash or in property
- 2 except income derived from the United States Government for
- 3 active duty outside the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as a member
- 4 of its armed forces and income from the United States Government
- 5 or the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for active State duty for
- 6 emergency within or outside the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania,
- 7 including duty ordered pursuant to 35 Pa.C.S. Ch. 76 (relating
- 8 to Emergency Management Assistance Compact). The exception in
- 9 this subparagraph for a member of the armed forces includes
- 10 <u>income of the spouse of such member, provided the spouse</u>
- 11 resides with the member outside the Commonwealth of
- 12 <u>Pennsylvania.</u>

- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
