AN ACT

Amending the act of May 3, 1933 (P.L.242, No.86), entitled "An act to promote the public health and safety by providing for examination, licensing and granting of permits for those who 2 3 desire to engage in the profession of cosmetology; defining cosmetology, and regulating cosmetology salons, schools, 5 students, apprentices, teachers, managers, manicurists and 6 cosmetologists; conferring powers and duties upon the Commissioner of Professional and Occupational Affairs of the 7 8 Department of State; providing for appeals to certain courts 9 10 by applicants and licensees; and providing penalties," further providing for definitions; and repealing provisions 11 relating to booth rental prohibited. 12 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 hereby enacts as follows: 15 Section 1. The definition of "booth space" in section 1 of 16 the act of May 3, 1933 (P.L.242, No.86), referred to as the 17 Cosmetology Law, is amended to read: 18 Section 1. Definitions .-- The following words and phrases when used in this act shall have the meanings given to them in 19 20 this section unless the context clearly indicates otherwise: 21 * * * 22 ["Booth space" means the area of a salon in which a licensed cosmetologist or a holder of a limited license provides to a 23

- 4 Section 2. Section 8.1 of the act is repealed:
- 5 [Section 8.1. Booth Rental Prohibited.--The rental of booth
- 6 space by an owner of a cosmetology salon, or the owner of a
- 7 salon limited to esthetics, nail technology or natural hair
- 8 braiding, to any holder of a license issued under this act is
- 9 unlawful.]
- 10 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
