AN ACT

1 Amending the act of July 23, 1970 (P.L.563, No.195), entitled
2 "An act establishing rights in public employes to organize
3 and bargain collectively through selected representatives;
4 defining public employes to include employes of nonprofit
5 organizations and institutions; providing compulsory
6 mediation and fact-finding, for collective bargaining
7 impasses; providing arbitration for certain public employes
8 for collective bargaining impasses; defining the scope of
9 collective bargaining; establishing unfair employe and
10 employer practices; prohibiting strikes for certain public
11 employes; permitting strikes under limited conditions;
12 providing penalties for violations; and establishing
13 procedures for implementation," in unfair practices, further
14 providing for prohibitions.

15 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
16 hereby enacts as follows:

17 Section 1. Section 1201(b) of the act of July 23, 1970
18 (P.L.563, No.195), known as the Public Employe Relations Act, is
19 amended by adding a clause to read:

20 Section 1201. * * *

21 (b) Employe organizations, their agents, or representatives,
22 or public employes are prohibited from:

1 * * *

2 (10) Using public funds to influence the decision of an
3 employe or an employe of a subcontractor on whether to join,
4 support or oppose a labor organization that represents or seeks
5 to represent an employe.

6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
