## AN ACT

- Amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions, further 2 providing for definitions; in Commonwealth services, further 3 providing for definitions relating to intrastate mutual aid 4 and for definitions relating to Fire and Emergency Medical 5 Services Loan Program; in volunteer firefighters, further 6 providing for definitions relating to fire relief association; in emergency responder mental wellness and 8 stress management, further providing for definitions; in 9 grants to fire companies and emergency medical services 10 companies, further providing for definitions; and, in 11 incentives for municipal volunteers of fire companies and 12 nonprofit emergency medical services agencies, further 13 providing for definitions. 14
