## AN ACT

Amending the act of May 28, 1937 (P.L.955, No.265), entitled "An act to promote public health, safety, morals, and welfare by 1 2 declaring the necessity of creating public bodies, corporate 3 and politic, to be known as housing authorities to engage in slum clearance, and to undertake projects, to provide 5 dwelling accommodations for persons of low income; providing for the organization of such housing authorities; defining 6 7 their powers and duties; providing for the exercise of such 8 9 powers, including the acquisition of property by purchase, gift or eminent domain, the renting and selling of property, 10 and including borrowing money, issuing bonds, and other 11 obligations, and giving security therefor; prescribing the 12 remedies of obligees of housing authorities; authorizing 13 housing authorities to enter into agreements, including 14 agreements with the United States, the Commonwealth, and 15 political subdivisions and municipalities thereof; defining 16 17 the application of zoning, sanitary, and building laws and regulations to projects built or maintained by such housing 18 19 authorities; exempting the property and securities of such housing authorities from taxation; and imposing duties and 20 conferring powers upon the State Planning Board, and certain 21 other State officers and departments," further providing for 22 23 organization of an authority.

- 24 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 25 hereby enacts as follows:
- 26 Section 1. Section 7(b) of the act of May 28, 1937 (P.L.955,
- 27 No.265), referred to as the Housing Authorities Law, is amended
- 28 to read:

- 1 Section 7. Organization of an Authority.--\* \* \*
- 2 (b) In an Authority in a city of the first class, the
- 3 executive director and staff with executive duties who report
- 4 directly to either the executive director or members of the
- 5 Authority shall [be at-will employes of the Authority and shall
- 6 serve at the pleasure of the members of the Authority. The
- 7 Authority shall not provide any payment or other thing of value
- 8 to such employes in connection with their separation from
- 9 employment, other than salary and benefits to which they are
- 10 entitled for regular employment through the date of separation.]
- 11 <u>serve in accordance with the terms and conditions approved in</u>
- 12 writing by the members of the Authority.
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
