AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of November 10, 1999 (P.L.491, No.45), entitled
- 2 "An act establishing a uniform construction code; imposing
- powers and duties on municipalities and the Department of
- 4 Labor and Industry; providing for enforcement; imposing
- 5 penalties; and making repeals," in training and certification
- of inspectors, providing for residential building inspectors.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of November 10, 1999 (P.L.491, No.45),
- 10 known as the Pennsylvania Construction Code Act, is amended by
- 11 adding a section to read:
- 12 <u>Section 704. Residential building inspectors.</u>
- 13 In addition to any other requirements from the department, a
- 14 residential building inspector shall also complete five hours of
- 15 continuing education in recognizing faulty construction
- 16 practices, including proper installation of stucco, the laws and
- 17 legal liability of builders in faulty construction practices and
- 18 the remedies available under Federal or State law for homeowners
- 19 <u>in addressing faulty construction practices.</u>

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
