## AN ACT

Amending the act of December 15, 1982 (P.L.1266, No.287), entitled "An act conferring limited residency status on military personnel, their dependents and civilian personnel 3 assigned to an active duty station in Pennsylvania," further 4 providing for residency of students. 5 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 7 8 Section 1. - 17 <u>(1)</u> THE PENNSYLVANIA STATE UNIVERSITY[, THE].
- 18 <u>(2) THE UNIVERSITY OF PITTSBURGH[,].</u>
- 19 <u>(3)</u> TEMPLE UNIVERSITY [AND].
- 20 (4) LINCOLN UNIVERSITY [AND THEIR BRANCH CAMPUSES].
- 21 "VETERAN." AN INDIVIDUAL WHO SERVED IN THE UNITED STATES
- 22 ARMED FORCES, INCLUDING A RESERVE COMPONENT OR THE NATIONAL
- 23 GUARD AND WHO WAS DISCHARGED OR RELEASED FROM SERVICE UNDER
- 24 CONDITIONS OTHER THAN DISHONORABLE. THE TERM INCLUDES AN
- 25 INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED IN 38 U.S.C. § 3319(B) (RELATING TO
- 26 AUTHORITY TO TRANSFER UNUSED EDUCATION BENEFITS TO FAMILY
- 27 MEMBERS).
