8	and Emergency Preparedness Committee of the House of
9	Representatives a report on the registry which shall include:
10	(1) The total number of veterans registered with the
11	department annually.
12	(2) The number of registrants received by each State
13	agency.
14	[(3) The number of veterans who choose not to be
15	included in the registry annually from each State agency.]
