## AN ACT

| 1  | Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled |
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| 2  | "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the     |
| 3  | executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the  |
| 4  | Executive Department thereof and the administrative           |
| 5  | departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof,       |
| 6  | including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or  |
| 7  | Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or      |
| 8  | authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative      |
| 9  | departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and |
| 10 | duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative |
| 11 | officers, and of the several administrative departments,      |
| 12 | boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the |
| 13 | Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive    |
| 14 | and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of |
| 15 | certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and      |
| 16 | other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, |
| 17 | and commissions; providing for judicial administration; and   |
| 18 | prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation   |
| 19 | of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of      |
| 20 | certain departments, boards and commissions shall be          |
| 21 | determined," in Commonwealth budget procedures, further       |
| 22 | providing for submission of budget to General Assembly and    |
| 23 | for transmission of budget information to the General         |
| 24 | Assembly.   |
| 25 | The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania      |
| 26 | hereby enacts as follows:                                     |

27 Section 1. Section 613(a) of the act of April 9, 1929 28 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, is

1 amended by adding a clause to read:

2 Section 613. Submission of Budget to General Assembly .-- (a) 3 As soon as possible after the organization of the General Assembly, but not later than the first full week in February of 4 each year, except in the case where a Governor has been elected 5 for his first term of office and then no later than the first 6 7 full week in March, the Governor shall submit to the General Assembly copies of original agency budget requests and all 8 9 subsequent revised agency budget requests and a State budget and program and financial plan embracing: 10

12 (6) Suggested legislative language necessary to implement 13 the operating budget and program and financial plan submitted 14 under this section. The following apply to suggested legislative 15 language submitted under this clause:

16 (i) The suggested legislative language shall be sent to each member of the General Assembly and made available on the Office 17 18 of the Budget's publicly accessible Internet website no later 19 than fifteen (15) days after the submissions are presented under clauses (1), (2) and (3). 20 21 (ii) The submission shall include a general appropriation bill, other appropriation bills, nonpreferred appropriation 22 23 bills or statutory authorizations, including language for 24 proposals for bills to raise revenue and proposals for formulas for distribution of money. 25 \* \* \* 26 27 Section 2. Section 619 of the act is amended by adding a subsection to read: 28

| 12 | (3) Citations to applicable State law governing the use,        |

| 14 | (4) Whether the appropriation or the program funded by the      |
| 15 | appropriation is required by Federal law.                       |
| 16 | (5) Citations to applicable Federal law governing the use,      |
| 17 | allocation or distribution of the money appropriated.           |
| 18 | (6) Whether the appropriation is augmented by other State       |
| 19 | money.  |
| 20 | (7) Whether the appropriation is augmented by Federal money.    |
| 21 | (8) Whether the appropriation is used to receive Federal        |
| 22 | matching funds.   |
| 23 | (9) Whether the appropriation is used to fund a program         |
| 24 | which, under Federal law, requires services to be provided to   |
| 25 | all eligible applicants regardless of the amount appropriated.  |
| 26 | (10) Whether the appropriation is used to fund a program        |
| 27 | which, under State law, requires services to be provided to all |
| 28 | eligible applicants regardless of the amount appropriated.      |
| 29 | Section 3. This act shall take effect January 1, 2024, or       |
