AN ACT

Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An 1 act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public 2 welfare laws of the Commonwealth," in public assistance, 3 further providing for definitions, for administration of assistance programs and for regulations for protection of 5 information. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 402 of the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, 10 No.21), known as the Human Services Code, is amended by adding definitions to read: 11 12 Section 402. Definitions .-- As used in this article, unless 13 the context clearly indicates otherwise: 14 * * * 15 "LIFE program" means a managed care program that provides 16 all-inclusive care for elderly individuals in this Commonwealth as established in accordance with 42 CFR Pt. 460 (relating to 17 programs of all-inclusive care for the elderly (PACE)). 18

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- 1 <u>"Older adult daily living center" means a premises operated</u>
- 2 for profit or not-for-profit in which older adult daily living
- 3 services are simultaneously provided for four or more clients
- 4 who are not relatives of the operator for part of a twenty-four-
- 5 <u>hour day.</u>

- 7 Section 2. Sections 403.1 and 404 of the act are amended by
- 8 adding subsections to read:
- 9 Section 403.1. Administration of Assistance Programs. --* * *
- 10 (f) The following apply:
- 11 (1) To ensure proper placement of applicants in Medicaid
- 12 managed care, the department shall, immediately after an
- 13 applicant is referred for Functional Eliqibility Determination
- 14 or has completed a PA-600 L:
- 15 (i) provide information necessary to determine eligibility
- 16 for home-based and community-based programs to LIFE program
- 17 organizations and older adult daily living center programs in
- 18 accordance with section 404; and
- 19 (ii) ensure that the applicant receives information about
- 20 the requirements and eligibility for programs offered by LIFE
- 21 program organizations and older adult daily living center
- 22 programs.
- 23 (2) The department may not assign an applicant to an option
- 24 for Medicaid managed care until the applicant has received an
- 25 assessment for home-based and community-based services.
- 26 (3) If an applicant fails to make a selection for Medicaid
- 27 managed care, the department shall proportionately assign
- 28 applicants based on available placement options for which the
- 29 applicant is deemed eligible.
- 30 (4) For the purposes of this subsection:

- 1 "Applicant" means an individual applying for medical_
- 2 assistance who is in need of long-term care.
- 3 "Medicaid managed care" means services provided by a Medicaid
- 4 managed care organization as defined in 42 U.S.C. § 1396b(m)(1)
- 5 (A) (relating to payment to states) that is a party to a
- 6 Medicaid managed care contract with the department. The term
- 7 <u>shall not include a behavioral health managed care organization</u>
- 8 that is a party to a Medicaid managed care contract with the
- 9 <u>department.</u>
- 10 Section 404. Regulations for Protection of Information. --* *

- 12 (a.1) The regulations for protection of information shall
- 13 permit the distribution of information to a LIFE program or
- 14 older adult daily living center program, for the purpose of
- 15 determining eligibility for home-based and community-based
- 16 services.

- 18 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
