## AN ACT

Designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 33758, carrying 1 Pennsylvania Route 427 over Sugar Creek in Sugarcreek 2 Borough, Venango County, as the Staff Sergeant Richard James 3 Mulholland Memorial Bridge. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Staff Sergeant Richard James Mulholland Memorial 8 Bridge. 9 Findings. -- The General Assembly finds and declares as 10 follows: 11 Richard James Mulholland was born January 23, 1992, 12 in Franklin, Venango County, and was a 2010 graduate of 13 Venango Catholic High School. 14 He served two deployments to Afghanistan with the 15 82nd Airborne, 2/504th Infantry Battalion in the United 16 States Army. 17 Upon being honorably discharged from active-duty 18 service, Staff Sergeant Mulholland enlisted in the 19 Pennsylvania Army National Guard, serving in the HHC, 2nd

- 2 HHC, 1st Battalion, 112th Infantry Battalion in Cambridge
- 3 Springs, Crawford County.
- 4 (4) For his service to the United States, Staff Sergeant
- 5 Mulholland was awarded the National Defense Service Medal,
- 6 the Combat Infantryman Badge, the Parachutist Badge, the Army
- 7 Good Conduct Medal, the Afghanistan Campaign Medal with two
- 8 campaign stars, the NATO Medal, the Global War on Terrorism
- 9 Medal, the Army Achievement Medal, the Army Service Medal and
- the Army Commendation Medal (3rd Award).
- 11 (5) Staff Sergeant Mulholland died on July 1, 2018. At
- the time of his death, he resided in Oil City, Venango
- 13 County.
- 14 (b) Designation. -- The bridge, identified as Bridge Key
- 15 33758, carrying Pennsylvania Route 427 over Sugar Creek in
- 16 Sugarcreek Borough, Venango County, is designated the Staff
- 17 Sergeant Richard James Mulholland Memorial Bridge.
- 18 (c) Signs. -- The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 19 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
- 20 traffic in both directions on the bridge.
- 21 Section 2. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect in 60 days.
