## AN ACT

Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in decorations, medals, badges and 2 awards, further providing for authorized decorations, medals, 3 badges and awards. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 3701(b)(2) and (3) of Title 51 of the 8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: § 3701. Authorized decorations, medals, badges and awards. 10 11 (b) Method of award. -- The following decorations, medals, 12 badges and awards will be awarded under the following conditions: 1.3 \* \* \* 14 15 The Pennsylvania Distinguished Service Medal shall 16 be awarded by the Governor to civilians, veterans [and],\_ 17 members of the Pennsylvania National Guard, Pennsylvania Guard or armed forces of the United States or their reserve 18

  2 <u>friendly foreign nation in recognition of meritorious service</u>
- 3 beyond the normal dictates of duty to this Commonwealth.
- 4 (3) The Pennsylvania Meritorious Service Medal shall be 5 awarded by the Governor to civilians, veterans [and], members 6 of the Pennsylvania National Guard, Pennsylvania Guard or the 7 armed forces of the United States or their reserve components
- 8 <u>and civilians and members of the military of a friendly</u>
- 9 <u>foreign nation</u> in recognition of meritorious service rendered
- this Commonwealth and while holding a position of great
- 11 responsibility or who provide meritorious service to veterans
- and their families on behalf of this Commonwealth.
