AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 12 (Commerce and Trade) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in Property Assessed Clean Energy
- 3 Program, further providing for purpose and for definitions.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 4301 of Title 12 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes, amended July 7, 2022 (P.L.470, No.43), is
- 8 amended to read:
- 9 § 4301. Purpose.
- 10 This chapter authorizes the establishment of a property
- 11 assessed clean energy program in the Commonwealth to ensure that
- 12 owners of agricultural, commercial and industrial properties can
- 13 obtain low-cost, long-term financing for energy efficiency,
- 14 <u>electric vehicle charging infrastructure</u>, indoor air quality,
- 15 resiliency improvement, water conservation and renewable energy
- 16 projects.
- 17 Section 2. The definition of "qualified project" in section

- 1 4302 of Title 12, amended July 7, 2022 (P.L.470, No.43), is
- 2 amended and the section is amended by adding a definition to
- 3 read:
- 4 § 4302. Definitions.
- 5 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 6 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 7 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 8 * * *
- 9 "Electric vehicle charging infrastructure project." The
- 10 addition of a facility or equipment that is used to charge a
- 11 battery or other energy storage device of a vehicle that is
- 12 <u>fully or partially powered by electricity.</u>
- 13 * * *
- "Qualified project." The installation or modification of a
- 15 permanent improvement fixed to a qualifying commercial property
- 16 that is a clean energy project, electric vehicle charging
- 17 <u>infrastructure project</u>, resiliency improvement project, indoor
- 18 air quality project, water conservation project or alternative
- 19 energy system and the installation is performed by a qualified
- 20 party in a district. The term includes installation of
- 21 alternative energy-generating equipment affixed to the land or
- 22 building.

- 24 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
