- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in bonds and
- recognizances, providing for use of cash bail.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 5703. Use of cash bail.
- 9 (a) Named depositor. -- If a defendant is the named depositor,
- 10 cash bail deposited by the defendant which is otherwise
- 11 returnable to the defendant shall be held and applied to the
- 12 payment of restitution, fees, fines and costs imposed upon the
- 13 defendant in connection with a criminal or delinquency case
- 14 <u>unless the defendant shows that the defendant would suffer an</u>
- 15 <u>undue hardship</u>.
- 16 (b) Other depositor.--If a defendant is not the named
- 17 depositor, the court may order, upon motion of the attorney for
- 18 the Commonwealth, that cash bail deposited on behalf of the
- 19 defendant which is otherwise returnable to the depositor be held

- 1 and applied to the payment of restitution, fees, fines and costs
- 2 imposed upon the defendant in connection with a criminal or
- 3 <u>delinguency case unless the depositor shows that the depositor</u>
- 4 would suffer an undue hardship.
- 5 (c) Notice. -- Written notice of the provisions of subsections
- 6 (a) and (b) shall be provided to a depositor prior to the
- 7 <u>acceptance of a deposit of cash bail.</u>
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 180 days.
