AN ACT

Amending the act of December 18, 2001 (P.L.949, No.114), entitled, as amended, "An act establishing a unified workforce development system; restructuring certain 2 3 administrative functions, procedures and entities; 4 transferring workforce development functions of Commonwealth 5 agencies; establishing the Pennsylvania Workforce Development 6 7 Board; providing for critical job training grants, for program quality and performance for workforce development 8 programs, for workforce leadership grants and for industry 9 partnerships; and authorizing local workforce development 10 11 boards," in preliminary provisions, further providing for definitions; in board, further providing for establishment, 12 for membership, for plan, functions and responsibilities, for 13 Commonwealth fiscal management accountability information 14 system and for performance accountability system; and, in 15 local workforce development areas and regions and local 16 workforce development boards, further providing for 17 establishment, for membership, for plan, functions and responsibilities and for local performance measures. 18 19 20 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 21 hereby enacts as follows: 22 Section 1. Section 103 of the act of December 18, 2001 23 (P.L.949, No.114), known as the Workforce Development Act, is amended by adding a definition to read: 25 Section 103. Definitions. 26 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall

- 13 The Pennsylvania Workforce Development Board is established
- 14 <u>within the Department of Community and Economic Development</u> to
- 15 advise and assist the Governor, the Deputy for Workforce
- 16 <u>Development</u> and the General Assembly on the implementation of a
- 17 unified system to assure a well-educated, highly skilled
- 18 workforce. The board is responsible for unifying the
- 19 Commonwealth's existing Federal and State workforce development
- 20 programs into an integrated system. All recommendations and
- 21 decisions of the board shall be in compliance with the Workforce
- 22 Innovation and Opportunity Act.

- 21 consist of the accountability measures specified in section

- 26 (a) Areas and regions.--

- 7 (a) Composition. -- The following apply:
- 8 (1) The Governor, in partnership with the board and the
- 9 <u>Deputy for Workforce Development</u>, shall establish criteria
- for use by chief elected officials in local workforce
- development areas for appointment of members to local
- workforce development boards. The following apply:

- 14 Section 504. Plan, functions and responsibilities.
- 15 (a) Local plan. -- A local workforce development board, in
- 16 partnership with the chief elected official, shall submit to the
- 17 Governor and the Deputy for Workforce Development for approval a
- 18 local plan. The local plan shall support the strategy described
- 19 in the State plan in accordance with section 102(b)(1)(E) of the
- 20 Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act, and otherwise be
- 21 consistent with the State plan. If the local area is part of a
- 22 planning region, the local workforce development board shall
- 23 comply with this section in the preparation and submission of a
- 24 regional plan. At the end of the first two-year period of the
- 25 four-year local plan, each local workforce development board
- 26 shall review the local plan and, in partnership with the chief

 2 which includes the opportunity for participation by current
 3 and potential customers, program partners, service providers
 4 and other local area stakeholders prior to the date on which
 5 the board submits a local plan to the Governor and the Deputy
 6 for Workforce Development for approval, the local workforce
 7 development board shall:
 - (i) make available copies of a proposed local plan to the public through electronic and other means, which may include public hearings and local news media; and
 - (ii) allow members of the public, including representatives of business, representatives of labor organizations and representatives of education, to submit to the local workforce development board comments on the proposed local plan not later than the end of the 30-day period beginning on the date on which the proposed local plan is made available.
 - include with the local plan submitted to the Governor and the Deputy for Workforce Development any comments received under paragraph (1)(ii) that represent public disagreement with the plan.

1 <u>Development</u> that meets the requirements in this section.

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(4) To coordinate with the Governor, the Deputy for Workforce Development, the board, Commonwealth agencies administering the core program and chief elected officials in establishing and operating a fiscal management accountability information system under section 305.1.

- (6) To compile an annual report and to submit the report to the Governor and the Deputy for Workforce Development by a deadline determined by the Governor. This report shall include, at a minimum:

- 14 (c) Regional planning. -- The following apply:

- 16 The Governor, after consultation with the Deputy for 17 Workforce Development and with local workforce development 18 boards and chief elected officials for the planning regions, 19 shall require local workforce development boards and chief 20 elected officials within a planning region to prepare, submit 21 and obtain approval of a single regional plan as specified in 22 section 106(c)(2) of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity 23 Act.

- 26 (a) General rule. -- The local workforce development board,
- 27 the chief elected officials, the Deputy for Workforce
- 28 <u>Development</u> and the Governor shall negotiate and reach agreement
- 29 on local levels of performance based on the State-adjusted
- 30 levels of performance for primary indicators established under

- 1 section 116(b)(3)(A) of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity
- 2 Act.
- 3 [(c) School-to-Work Opportunities Act of 1994.--No funds
- 4 made available under the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity
- 5 Act shall be used to develop or continue programs or activities
- 6 created under the School-to-Work Opportunities Act of 1994
- 7 (Public Law 103-239, 108 Stat. 568).]
