## AN ACT

- Amending Title 25 (Elections) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in voter registration, further providing for qualifications to register, for government agencies and for preparation and distribution of applications; and, in voting procedures, further providing for application for absentee
- 6 ballots.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Sections 1301(a), 1325(b)(4) and 1327(a)(4)(iii)
- 10 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are
- 11 amended to read:
- 12 § 1301. Qualifications to register.
- 13 (a) Eliqibility.--An individual who will be at least 18
- 14 years of age on the day of the next election, who has been a
- 15 citizen of the United States for at least one month prior to the
- 16 next election and who has resided in this Commonwealth and the
- 17 election district where the individual offers to vote for at
- 18 least 30 days prior to the next ensuing election [and has not
- 19 been confined in a penal institution for a conviction of a

- 1 felony within the last five years] shall be eligible to register
- 2 as provided in this chapter.

- 4 § 1325. Government agencies.
- 5 \* \* \*
- 6 (b) Forms. -- An agency designated in subsection (a) shall
- 7 provide a form for office visits or, if the agency provides
- 8 services to persons with disabilities, for home visits which
- 9 contains all of the following:

- 11 (4) The statement "In order to be qualified to register
- to vote, you must be at least 18 years of age on the day of
- 13 the next election, you must have been a citizen of the United
- 14 States for at least one month prior to the next election and
- have resided in Pennsylvania and the election district where
- 16 you plan to vote for at least 30 days prior to the next
- election[, and you must not have been confined in a penal
- institution for a conviction of a felony within the last five
- 19 years]."

- 21 § 1327. Preparation and distribution of applications.
- 22 (a) Form.--
- 23 \* \* \*
- 24 (4) A voter registration application shall be printed on
- 25 stock of good quality and shall be of suitable uniform size.
- Nothing in this part shall prohibit the design and use of an
- 27 electronic voter registration application which includes the
- applicant's digitized or electronic signature. The
- 29 registration application shall contain the following
- information; however, the information may be provided on a

separate form for voter registration made under section 1323

Notice that the applicant must be a citizen of 4 the United States for at least one month prior to the 5 next election and a resident of this Commonwealth and the 6 7 election district for at least 30 days and must be at 8 least 18 years of age by the day of the next ensuing election [and has not been confined in a penal 9 institution for a conviction of a felony within the last 10 five years]. The notice required in this subparagraph 11 12 shall be in print identical to the declaration under

- 19 (a) General rule. -- Notwithstanding the provisions of Part IV
- 20 (relating to voter registration) or the act of June 3, 1937
- 21 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the Pennsylvania Election Code, the
- 22 following persons may make application for an absentee ballot by
- 23 sending a letter or other signed document to the county board of
- 24 elections in the county in which the person's voting address is
- 25 located:

- 27 <u>(5) An inmate who is confined in a correctional</u>
- institution and who is eligible to register to vote as

- 2 (e) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 3 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 4 <u>subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 5 "Correctional institution." A penal institution,
- 6 penitentiary, State farm, reformatory, prison, jail, house of
- 7 correction, juvenile detention facility or other institution for
- 8 the incarceration or custody of persons under sentence for
- 9 <u>offenses or awaiting trial or sentence for offenses.</u>
- "Inmate." An offender who is committed to, under sentence to
- 11 or confined in a correctional institution and who is eligible to
- 12 register to vote as provided under section 1301. The term does
- 13 not include an individual convicted under section 1703 (relating
- 14 to application) or an offense under the Pennsylvania Election
- 15 Code.
- 16 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
