A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 2 3	Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, further providing for qualifications of certain judges.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby resolves as follows:
6	Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
7	Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
8	That section 12(b) of Article V be amended to read:
9	§ 12. Qualifications of justices, judges and justices of the
10	peace.
11	* * *
12	(b) Justices of the peace shall be members of the bar of the
13	Supreme Court or shall complete a course of training and
14	instruction in the duties of their respective offices and pass
15	an examination prior to [assuming office.] being nominated to
16	fill vacancies pursuant to section 13(b) of this article or to
17	filing a nomination petition for their respective offices. Such
18	courses and examinations shall be as provided by law.

Section 2. The following procedure applies to the proposed
 constitutional amendment in this joint resolution:

3 (1) Upon the first passage by the General Assembly of
4 the amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall
5 proceed immediately to comply with the advertising
6 requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution
7 of Pennsylvania.

(2) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of 8 9 the amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the advertising 10 11 requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania. The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall 12 submit the amendment to the qualified electors of this 13 14 Commonwealth at the first general or municipal election which 15 meets the requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the 16 Constitution of Pennsylvania.
