8	Section 1. Section 13(f) of the act of May 1, 1984 (P.L.206,
9	No.43), known as the Pennsylvania Safe Drinking Water Act, is

14	(f) Preenforcement conferenceNotwithstanding any other
15	provision of this act, before the department, the Office of
16	Attorney General or the district attorney of the affected county
17	shall institute any criminal proceedings against any person
18	pursuant to subsections (c), (d) and (e) it shall, in writing,

1 provide such person with an opportunity for a preenforcement

2 conference with the department.

3 (f.1) Criminal proceedings.--The Office of Attorney General 4 under the act of October 15, 1980 (P.L.950, No.164), known as 5 the Commonwealth Attorneys Act, or the district attorney of the 6 affected county may institute any criminal proceedings against 7 any person pursuant to subsections (c), (d) and (e). 8 * * * 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
