AN ACT

1 2	Amending the act of October 27, 1955 (P.L.744, No.222), entitled "An act prohibiting certain practices of discrimination
∠ 3	because of race, color, religious creed, ancestry, age or
3 4	national origin by employers, employment agencies, labor
5	organizations and others as herein defined; creating the
6	Pennsylvania Human Relations Commission in the Governor's
7	Office; defining its functions, powers and duties; providing
8	for procedure and enforcement; providing for formulation of
9	an educational program to prevent prejudice; providing for
10	judicial review and enforcement and imposing penalties,"
11	further providing for definitions and for unlawful
12	discriminatory practices.
13	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
10	
14	hereby enacts as follows:
15	Section 1. Sections 4 and 5 of the act of October 27, 1955
16	(P.L.744, No.222), known as the Pennsylvania Human Relations
17	Act, are amended by adding clauses to read:
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18	Section 4. DefinitionsAs used in this act unless a
19	different meaning clearly appears from the context:
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1	(bb) The term "attendant care services" includes the
2	following:
3	(1) Services that enable an eligible individual to live in
4	the eligible individual's home and community and to carry out
5	the functions of daily living, self-care and mobility which
6	shall include:
7	(i) Getting in and out of a bed, wheelchair or motor
8	<u>vehicle.</u>
9	(ii) Assistance with routine bodily functions, including:
10	(A) Health maintenance activities.
11	(B) Bathing and personal hygiene.
12	(C) Dressing and grooming.
13	(D) Feeding, including preparation and cleanup.
14	(E) Critical cognitive tasks and tasks required to
15	participate in community events, including managing
16	transportation, handling tickets and communicating with others.
17	(2) The services provided to an individual who is eligible
18	for a home and community-based waiver under 42 U.S.C. § 1396n(c)
19	(relating to compliance with State plan and payment provisions).
20	(cc) The term "eligible individual" includes an individual
21	with a disability who requires assistance to complete activities
22	of daily living, self-care and mobility, including attendant
23	<u>care services.</u>
24	(dd) The term "personal care attendant" includes an
25	individual who provides attendant care services to an eligible
26	individual.
27	Section 5. Unlawful Discriminatory PracticesIt shall be
28	an unlawful discriminatory practice, unless based upon a bona
29	fide occupational qualification, or in the case of a fraternal
30	corporation or association, unless based upon membership in such
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1 association or corporation, or except where based upon 2 applicable security regulations established by the United States 3 or the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania: 4 * * *

(m) It shall be an unlawful discriminatory practice for any
person being the owner, lessee, proprietor, manager,

7 <u>superintendent</u>, agent or employe of a public accommodation to

8 not provide free admission to a personal care attendant whose

9 attendance is necessary to enable an eligible individual to

10 attend or tour an entertainment, educational, sporting or other

11 event open to the public which charges admission. The personal

12 care attendant is not required to be provided a seat with a view

13 of the event and may be directed to a seat and location in close

14 proximity to the eligible individual where the eligible

15 <u>individual may be accommodated.</u>

16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
