Pennsylvania Fire and Emergency Medical Services Loan 10 Program. 11 12 (d) Limitation. -- Notwithstanding subsection (a), a fire 1.3 company may not qualify for the Pennsylvania Fire and Emergency 14 Medical Services Loan established under this section if the fire 15 company: 16 (1) operates in the same county as a licensed facility under 4 Pa.C.S. Pt. II (relating to gaming); and 17 (2) receives funding under 4 Pa.C.S. (relating to 18
