AN ACT

- Amending the act of December 9, 2002 (P.L.1701, No.214), 1 entitled "An act protecting the free exercise of religion; 2 and prescribing the conditions under which government may 3 substantially burden a person's free exercise of religion," further providing for definitions and for free exercise of 5 religion protected. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. The definition of "substantially burden" in 10 section 3 of the act of December 9, 2002 (P.L.1701, No.214),

- 17 "Adverse action." The application of a civil or criminal
- 18 penalty or the imposition of an administrative sanction.

- 1 "Substantially burden." An agency action which does any of
- 2 the following:
- 3 (1) Significantly constrains or inhibits conduct or
- 4 expression mandated by a person's sincerely held religious
- 5 beliefs.
- 6 (2) Significantly curtails a person's ability to express
- 7 adherence to the person's religious faith.
- 8 (3) Denies a person a reasonable opportunity to engage
- 9 in activities which are fundamental to the person's religion.
- 10 (4) Compels conduct or expression which violates a
- 11 specific tenet of a person's religious faith.
- 12 <u>(5) Prevents a person from physically assembling or</u>
- gathering in order to engage in the free exercise of
- 14 religion, including preventing a person from traveling for
- the purpose of physically assembling or gathering in order to
- 16 engage in the free exercise of religion.
- 17 (6) Authorizes any adverse action against a person for
- the person's free exercise of religion.

- 23 (c) Limitation on exception. -- No order issued pursuant to
- 24 the authority granted under section 20 of Article IV of the
- 25 Constitution of Pennsylvania, 35 Pa.C.S. § 7301 (relating to
- 26 general authority of Governor) or a control measure taken under
- 27 the act of April 23, 1956 (1955 P.L.1510, No.500), known as the
- 28 <u>Disease Prevention and Control Law of 1955, may be used by an</u>
- 29 agency for the purposes of an exception under subsection (b).
- 30 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
