8 (a) Funding.--[The department may use Federal, State and

9 other money to the extent that it is made available for the

10 program.] To award grants under the pilot program, the

11 department may use up to \$300,000 annually of undistributed

12 <u>funds not expended, encumbered or committed from appropriations</u>

13 or restricted accounts for grants and subsidies made to the

14 department to award grants. The funds shall be transferred by

15 the Secretary of the Budget to a restricted account as necessary

16 to award grants and, when transferred, are appropriated to carry
