of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate, the chairperson and minority chairperson of the Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives, the chairperson and minority chairperson of the Consumer Protection and Professional Licensure Committee of the Senate and the chairperson and minority chairperson of the Professional Licensure Committee of the House of Representatives that contains all of the following:

8 (1) An accounting of funds expended by the Bureau of 9 Professional and Occupational Affairs related to the 10 replacement of the PA Licensure System by category of 11 expenditure.

12 A status update on the implementation and timeline (2)13 of the replacement project, including a description of 14 efforts to improve or upgrade Bureau of Professional and Occupational Affairs technology infrastructure, to interface 15 with educational institutions in this Commonwealth, to 16 17 facilitate and expedite education verification, to fully 18 implement licensure compacts enacted in statute and improve the timely issuance of professional licenses. 19

20 (3) Any other information deemed necessary or21 appropriate by the department.

22 Section 2. (a) The sum of \$11,025,000, or as much thereof 23 as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the restricted 24 receipts account of the State Board of Medicine for the 25 operation of the board for the fiscal year July 1, 2024, to June 26 30, 2025.

(b) The sum of \$3,204,000, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the restricted receipts account of the State Board of Osteopathic Medicine for the operation of the board for the fiscal year July 1, 2024, to June

2 (C) The sum of \$454,000, or as much thereof as may be 3 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the restricted receipts account of the State Board of Podiatry for the operation of the 4 board for the fiscal year July 1, 2024, to June 30, 2025. 5 The sum of \$946,000, or as much thereof as may be 6 (d) 7 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the Athletic Commission 8 Augmentation Account for the State Athletic Commission, as authorized by 5 Pa.C.S. § 1512 (relating to Athletic Commission 9 Augmentation Account), for the support and operation of the 10 commission for the fiscal year July 1, 2024, to June 30, 2025. 11 12 (e) Each appropriation listed in subsections (a), (b), (c) 13 and (d) shall not be treated as an augmentation to the 14 Department of State, a general government appropriation or any other appropriation, but shall be treated and accounted for as 15 16 separate appropriations respectively.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2024, orimmediately, whichever is later.
