A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating June 1, 2023, as "Skip the Straw Day" in
- 2 Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Plastic debris harms more than 1,200 species across
- 4 the globe; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Plastics, microplastics and plastic microfibers
- 6 contaminate mountain peaks and ocean trenches; and
- 7 WHEREAS, These materials and particles infiltrate our soil,
- 8 drinking water and the air we breathe; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Contributing to this crisis, Americans generate
- 10 waste from an estimated 500 million single-use disposable
- 11 plastic straws each day; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Banning, phasing out or otherwise reducing plastic
- 13 straw use involves small actions to change habits and broader
- 14 actions to change cultures; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Making straws available only on request is a start;
- 16 and
- 17 WHEREAS, Food and beverage concessionaires for the National

- 1 Park Service and other venues are adhering to offer-first
- 2 practices; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Straws manufactured from paper, compostable plastic,
- 4 glass, bamboo, corn or stainless steel are alternatives when
- 5 skipping the straw; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Antistraw initiatives include The Last Plastic
- 7 Straw, Be Straw Free, Choose to Refuse, Be the Solution to
- 8 Pollution, Strawless Summer and StopSucking; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Municipalities and venues in this Commonwealth are
- 10 beginning to address the challenges of plastic straw waste;
- 11 therefore be it
- 12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate June 1,
- 13 2023, as "Skip the Straw Day" in Pennsylvania.
