A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the month of September 2023 as "Suicide Prevention Awareness Month" and September 10, 2023, as "World Suicide
- 3 Prevention Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 4 WHEREAS, Suicide accounted for 48,183 deaths in 2021, with
- 5 approximately one death from suicide occurring every 11 minutes;
- 6 and
- 7 WHEREAS, More than 700,000 people around the world die by
- 8 suicide each year; and
- 9 WHEREAS, According to the World Health Organization, the
- 10 COVID-19 pandemic triggered a 25% increase in the prevalence of
- 11 anxiety and depression; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Suicide is on the rise again after two years of
- 13 decline; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Suicide is the eleventh leading cause of death in
- 15 the United States and the second leading cause of death for
- 16 those 10 to 14 years of age; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Stigma surrounding mental health and suicide
- 2 prevents many individuals who are contemplating suicide from
- 3 seeking and receiving appropriate treatment; therefore be it
- 4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 5 month of September 2023 as "Suicide Prevention Awareness Month"
- 6 and September 10, 2023, as "World Suicide Prevention Day" in
- 7 Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 9 seriousness of the issue of suicide in Pennsylvania and
- 10 encourage the education of Pennsylvania residents on the matter.
