A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the month of June 2024 as "Pennsylvania Municipal
2 Retirement System Month" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, On February 3, 1974, the General Assembly of
4 Pennsylvania enacted Act 15 of 1974, known as the Pennsylvania
5 Municipal Retirement Law, establishing the Pennsylvania
6 Municipal Retirement System as an independent, State-affiliated
7 agency; and

8 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System has
9 served our local government employees for half a century,
10 providing financial stability to countless retirees; and

11 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System
12 currently has more than 1,060 plans, 18,000 members and \$3.3
13 billion in assets; and

14 WHEREAS, The dedicated work of our retirement administration
15 employees has contributed to the financial preparedness of our
16 local government employees; and

17 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System has
18 demonstrated unwavering commitment to fiscal responsibility,

1 prudent investment management and transparent governance; and

2 WHEREAS, The retirement system's longevity reflects its
3 resilience, adaptability and dedication to serving our local
4 government public servant employees; therefore be it

5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
6 month of June 2024 as "Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System
7 Month" in Pennsylvania; and be it further

8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives celebrate the 50-
9 year anniversary of the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System
10 and commend its invaluable contributions to our community; and
11 be it further

12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge all
13 Pennsylvanians to join us in honoring this milestone and express
14 our gratitude to everyone involved in ensuring the financial
15 well-being of our local government retirees.
