AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
 2 Statutes, in general provisions, providing for restrictions
 3 on appropriations; and making a repeal.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
 5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

8 § 105. Restrictions on appropriations.

9 (a) Motor License Fund.--

10 (1) The appropriations to the Pennsylvania State Police
 11 from the Motor License Fund shall be as follows:

12 (i) For fiscal year 2023-2024, the total amount of
 13 the appropriation shall not exceed \$250,000,000.

14 (ii) For fiscal year 2024-2025, the total amount of
 15 the appropriation shall not exceed \$200,000,000.

16 (iii) For fiscal year 2025-2026, the total amount of
 17 the appropriation shall not exceed \$150,000,000.

18 (iv) For fiscal year 2026-2027, the total amount of

1 the appropriation shall not exceed \$100,000,000.

2 (v) For fiscal year 2027-2028, the total amount of
3 the appropriation shall not exceed \$50,000,000.

4 (vi) For fiscal year 2028-2029, and each fiscal year
5 thereafter, the appropriation shall be \$0.

6 (2) An appropriation under paragraph (1) shall be
7 expended in accordance with section 11 of Article VIII of the
8 Constitution of Pennsylvania.

9 (b) (Reserved).

10 Section 2. Repeals are as follows:

11 (1) The General Assembly declares that the repeal under
12 paragraph (2) is necessary to effectuate the addition of 75
13 Pa.C.S. § 105.

14 (2) Section 1798.2-E(7), (8), (9), (10) and (11) of the
15 act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), known as The Fiscal
16 Code, are repealed.

17 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
