AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto, " in terms and courses of study,
- providing for moment of silence on September 11 anniversary.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 Section 1555. Moment of Silence on September 11
- 13 Anniversary. -- (a) Each school entity shall conduct a moment of
- 14 silence during instructional hours for students and faculty to
- 15 observe the anniversary of September 11, 2001, as a remembrance
- 16 of the thousands of military servicepersons, government
- 17 <u>employees, civilians and emergency responders who lost their</u>
- 18 lives or were wounded by terrorist attacks on that date.
- 19 (b) The Department of Education shall establish a model
- 20 curriculum for instruction in the events and significance of

- 1 September 11, 2001, no later than twelve (12) months after the
- 2 <u>effective date of this section</u>. The model curriculum shall
- 3 include, but not be limited to, all of the following topics
- 4 where appropriate:
- 5 <u>(1) The historical context of terrorism.</u>
- 6 (2) The terrorist attacks on the World Trade Center, the
- 7 Pentagon and United Airlines Flight 93 which crashed in
- 8 <u>Shanksville</u>, <u>Pennsylvania</u>.
- 9 (3) American recovery and response to the attacks.
- 10 (4) Global challenges and consequences in a post-September
- 11 <u>11 world.</u>
- 12 (c) The Department of Education shall make available on the
- 13 department's publicly accessible Internet website curriculum
- 14 materials and other available resources regarding the events and
- 15 <u>significance of September 11, 2001, for voluntary use by school</u>
- 16 entities.
- 17 (d) Nothing in subsections (b) and (c) shall be construed to
- 18 require a school entity or nonpublic school to implement, adopt
- 19 or use the curriculum, materials and other resources made
- 20 available by the department under this section.
- (e) For purposes of this section, the term "school entity"
- 22 shall mean a school district, charter school, regional charter
- 23 school, cyber charter school, intermediate unit or area career
- 24 and technical school.
- 25 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
