AN ACT

1 Amending Title 71 (State Government) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for the prohibition of
3 unauthorized applications.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 71 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7 Statutes is amended by adding a part to read:

2 § 7301. Definitions.

3 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
4 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
5 context clearly indicates otherwise:

6 "Electronic device." A device that is capable of downloading
7 and accessing an unauthorized application.

8 "State-owned." State money was used in acquiring the device.

9 "Unauthorized application." The social networking service
10 TikTok or any successor application or service developed or
11 provided by ByteDance Limited or an entity owned by ByteDance
12 Limited.

13 § 7302. Prohibition.

14 (a) On device.--Within three months of the effective date of
15 this subsection, a State-owned electronic device may not have an
16 unauthorized application downloaded or installed on the device.

17 (b) On network.--An individual may not access an
18 unauthorized application on a State wireless network.

19 (c) Exception.--Subsection (a) shall not apply to law
20 enforcement activities, security interests, security research or
21 risk mitigation actions.

22 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
