6	Section 1. Section 1921 of Title 1 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
8	§ 1921. Legislative intent controls.

10	(d) Deference
11	(1) If words of a statute are not explicit, the
12	<pre>following shall apply:</pre>
13	(i) The ambiguity of the statute may not be
14	interpreted as an implicit delegation to a Commonwealth
15	department, agency, board or commission of legislative
16	rulemaking authority.
17	(ii) The ambiguity of the statute may not be used as
18	justification for any of the following:

1	(A) Interpreting the authority of a Commonwealth
2	department, agency, board or commission expansively.
3	(B) Deferring to the interpretation of a
4	Commonwealth department, agency, board or commission
5	on the question of law.
6	(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this
7	subsection shall apply to the judicial review of an action by
8	a Commonwealth department, agency, board or commission under
9	the laws of this Commonwealth.
10	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
