## AN ACT

Amending the act of February 14, 2008 (P.L.6, No.3), entitled "An act providing for access to public information, for a 2 designated open-records officer in each Commonwealth agency, 3 local agency, judicial agency and legislative agency, for 4 procedure, for appeal of agency determination, for judicial 5 review and for the Office of Open Records; imposing 6 penalties; providing for reporting by State-related 7 institutions; requiring the posting of certain State contract 8 information on the Internet; and making related repeals," in 9 procedure, further providing for exceptions for public 10 11 records. 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: 14 Section 1. Section 708(b)(12) of the act of February 14, 15 2008 (P.L.6, No.3), known as the Right-to-Know Law, is amended to read: 16 17 Section 708.
